

## Tips.

Safety for your property & Waste Management driver:

- » Maintain clear and safe access to containers
- » Make sure containers are in an open or well lit area
- » Overhead clearance must be a minimum of 14 feet

### Avoiding delay of service:

- » Ensure no vehicles are parked in front or on sides of containers
- » Please have gates or access to containers unlocked for service

#### Keeping a clean area:

- » To avoid spillage, container lids and side doors should be closed
- » If you have additional volumes of waste, please keep them clear of the service area

# The following items are NOT allowed in general waste containers.

- » Appliances
- » Batteries (Auto and Small Device)
- » Electronics
- » Hazardous Waste
- » Medical Waste
- » Radioactive Materials
- » Any Types of Oil Including Oil Rags
- » Asbestos
- » Chemical Products

- » Flammables
- » Herbicides/Pesticides
- » Needles
- » Tires
- » Bodily Semi Solids and Bodily Fluids
- » Construction Debris
- » Fluorescent Tubes
- » Liquids
- » Paint and Thinners
- » Yard Waste
